Key Gift Aid Facts

When the Janki Saye Foundation receives a direct donation from a UK taxpayer, we are entitled to claim an amount of tax (calculated at the basic rate of income tax in that year) paid on that donation. Once you have given your permission for us to do this on your behalf (by completing this Gift Aid form), there is no need for you to do anything else.

All that is required is that you must be a taxpayer and that you would have paid or will pay sufficient Income and/or Capital Gains Tax to cover all the Gift Aid claimed on your donations in that tax year. Please note that it is your responsibility to pay the difference.

The amount of tax we claim will be the 25% of the total value of your donations in that tax year. If you pay Income Tax at the higher rate and want to receive additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

If your tax situation changes and your gifts will no longer be eligible for the Gift Aid scheme, please contact us and we will amend your record accordingly.
